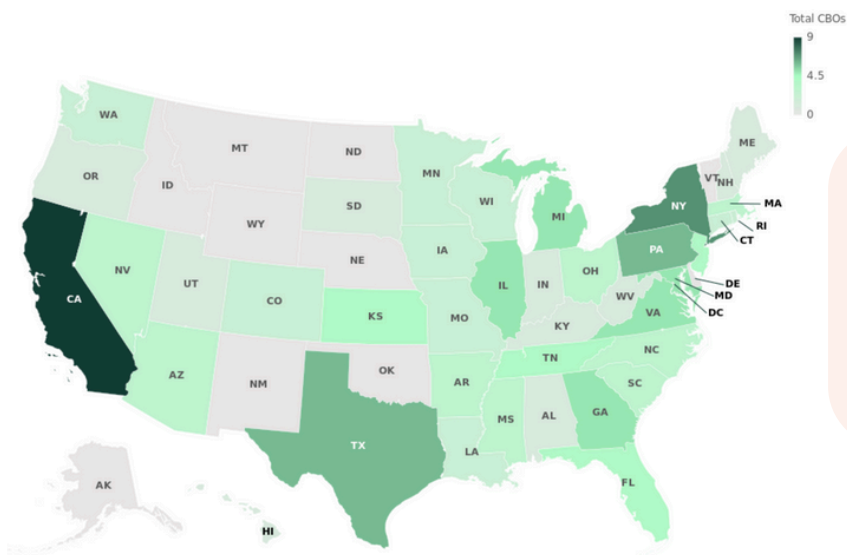


# VACCINE EQUITY & ACCESS PROGRAM

## EMPOWERING COMMUNITIES FOR CHANGE

Launched at the height of the COVID-19 pandemic, Community Catalyst's Vaccine Equity and Access Program (VEAP) set out to build vaccine confidence, access, and equity among racially and ethnically minoritized communities. By resourcing trusted community-based organizations as message creators—not just amplifiers—VEAP flipped the script on traditional public health initiatives, demonstrating that community-based organizations are vital components of the public health workforce due to their cultural competence, established community trust, and deep understanding of their communities' needs. **In a moment of shrinking public health infrastructure and rising mis/disinformation, VEAP offers a roadmap for what's possible when we stop talking at communities and start investing in them.**



Over the past 4 years, VEAP has funded **125** community-based organizations in **42 states, D.C. and Puerto Rico.**
